

LETTER OF ANNOUNCEMENT EAMS "Go-live" date & next steps

6th February 2023

EMVO is pleased to announce that the European Alert Management System (EAMS) Hub is technically ready and will be officially live on Thursday 9th February 2023. Therefore, all interested OBPs and NMVOs in using the system can start connecting from 9th February onwards. Be reminded that this is the start of a long journey during which we hope as many interested OBPs and NMVOs connect and take advantage of the functionalities the system offers.

The EAMS aims to assist you in investigating alerts **quickly, cost-effectively, and efficiently**. Currently, the following functionalities are available:

- Create and manage users and groups
- See the list and details of alerts
- Change status messages and files for one or more alerts
- Export alerts and import actions for mass updates

The team is working diligently to resolve any remaining issues, which are summarised with the expected time to resolution in the **EAMS Technical Pilot Report** available <u>here</u> and also in the **EAMS Process Pilot Report** available <u>here</u>. The reports provide an overview of the main findings and implications and describe recommended actions for OBPs and MAHs.

EMVO is also excited to confirm that the **Cyprus NMVO (KOEF)** is the **first market to connect to the EAMS** in productive use. We hope this further encourages the other markets to follow this example and join the project. EMVO will continue to update the EMVS Community on the status of the connected markets.
